To refresh memories, minutes of the July 29 meeting were reviewed.

An agreement was reached indicating the organization should take steps necessary to become incorporated.

A discussion was held regarding the cumbersome nature of the name, "Brandywine-Susquehanna Trail", and it was approved to tentatively adopt an alternate name, "Mason-Dixon Trail System". Under this title trail segments would adopt locally derived names, i.e. "Brandywine Section". Other suggested names were Pennardel, Chesapeake, DuPont, Gunpowder, or historic figures.

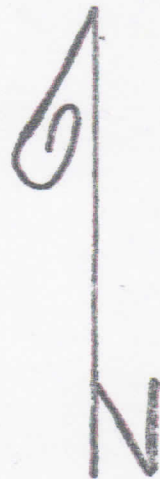
